Season 4 of Angels on Stage has been a year of progress, teamwork, and illumination of incredible abilities. Over the past summer the AoS board worked diligently to develop organizational charts and hire more professional and student staff who thrive in his/her particular area. Systems have been established which allow individuals and teams of people to work together cooperatively, efficiently, and to set each respective area up for optimal success.

Resources have come in through grants and in-kind donations which have allowed AoS to acquire state-of-the-art tech equipment. A tremendous thank you is extended to the Evergreen Valley College for adopting Angels on Stage as their Artist in Residence theatre Troupe. The community partnerships being forged and solidified is truly inspirational.

With a return rate of over 95%, many of these performers have been with AoS for 3 and even all 4 years. AoS has grown to serving 100 Angels with a growing waitlist. The time is ripe to illuminate abilities of all children through the medium of musical theatre. Angels on Stage is committed to developing a model which is flexible and functional, and which can be embraced and operationalized by communities across the country. 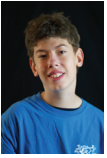

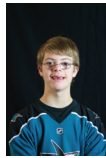
